

AI Use Policy for English Courses

Wroclaw University of Science and Technology

Purpose and Scope

This policy explains how students can use Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools in English classes. The goal is to help students learn English with AI support, but still do their own work and think independently.

Permitted AI Uses

- You can use AI tools (like ChatGPT, Grammarly, or DeepL) to:
 - Check grammar or improve vocabulary
 - Get explanations (Your prompt **must** start with "Explain ...")
- You must always read, correct, and improve any AI text before using it.

Prohibited AI Uses

- **AI cannot be used during exams, tests, or any graded in-class work.**
- You must not copy and submit AI-generated texts as your own work.
- Do not use AI to write essays, reports, or translations without your own changes and ideas.
- Do not use AI to invent sources, quotes, or false information.

Disclosure Requirements

- If you use AI for an assignment, you must **say so clearly** (for example, in a note or at the end of your work).

Teacher Responsibilities

- Teachers will explain what kinds of AI use are allowed for each task.
- Teachers will show how to use AI in a safe, honest, and useful way.

Ethical Principles

- **Originality** – Do your own thinking and writing.
- **Transparency** – Always be open about using AI.
- **Integrity** – Be honest and avoid cheating or plagiarism.
